Structure and Objective

The Project will provide *technical and financial resources* to develop four Framework Cross Border Initiatives among Mediterranean enterprises and other business support organizations in 3 macro areas:

Internationalization	1. Fashion Re-Start
Innovation	2. Health Emergencies3. Dyeing Small Batches
Circular Economy	4. CIRCULAR ECONOMY IN THE T/C SECTOR

The <u>final goal</u> is to establish new <u>**«Euro-Mediterranean Alliances»**</u> among enterprises/organizations that may strengthen their long-term market position.













Framework Initiative: CIRCULAR ECONOMY IN THE T/C SECTOR

The Initiative is coordinated by **Confindustria Toscana Nord.**

It aims at stimulating innovative practises for recycling of fibres, fabrics and final products to create sustainable fashion collections, and makes available raw materials and equipment of high quality for fashion clothing at affordable costs.

It covers Specific initiatives, such as:

- Develop waste to Sub-products portfolio
- Re-use of Leftovers and Second-hand textile machines
- Support in the creation of Patchwork collections













Project's TOOLS for Circular Economy

1. Open Forum for Circular Economy

A *«digital knowledge continuative asset»* shared by the TMA project partners and available to all enterprises, organizations, professionals, research and service centres of the Programme Area.

2. Leftovers Virtual Market Place

The Initiative is activating and will constantly update a virtual market places hosted by a Facebook Group to enable the matching of raw materials sellers and buyers.
