The Raziff accelerator is a municipal innovation center in a restored old bus station building in an underdeveloped area. The Raziff aims to connect residents, social and technological entrepreneurs, companies and organizations with the aim of generating solutions, testing and implementing them in the urban space with the cooperation of all stakeholders. It provides work spaces, training and workshops, and a meeting place for local entrepreneurs and those who want to contribute to improving the quality of life in the area or who encourage local entrepreneurship. In terms of the SME4SMARTCITIES activities, the Raziff accelerator is an opportunity to study the actual engagement of SMEs and Municipal collaboration in the Tel Aviv innovation ecosystem leader. The area is also being analysed as an appropriate candidate for the project Innovation Mile (A5.1.7).
