



## 1.LA GRANDE TRAVERSÉE DU DAHAR from Tamezret to Douiret

#### DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE


The trail, in a mountainous region on the edge of the Sahara, not far from the island of Djerba, crosses the Dahar mountain range, and nine municipalities in the governorates of Gabès, Médenine and Tataouine, passing through Tamezret, Matmata, Toujane, Beni Khedache, Ghomrassen, Douiret and Chenini. From the Berber village of Tamezret to the Ksour of Ghomrassen, from the "Dinosaur Trail" to the troglodytes of Douiret, the trail allows visitors to explore the striking landscapes of Dahar on foot!

The region is full of curiosities: geological sites, fossils, traditional granaries, oil presses, wild flora... You can hike alone (marking is in progress) or with a guide native to the region.



### 2. ZAGHOUAN NATIONAL PARK from Sidi Bougabrine

**TUNISIA** 

#### DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

Zaghouan is an historic town in northeast Tunisia, spreading over the slope of Mount Zaghwan (1295m). The city is an agricultural centre and is known for the production of rose essence.

Zaghouan houses parts of a Roman aqueduct and canal network that was constructed during the time of the Emperor Hadrian in the second century BC. These infrastructures, starting at the so-called Water Temple, carried water for more than 130km from Zaghouan to Carthage.

This area is known as well for its hiking trails, including the "water trail", which follows the historic path from Zaghouan to Carthage. There are also plenty of interesting trails to walk along in the Zaghouan National Park and in the urban parkland around the Water Temple.

# 4. **EL FEIDJA NATIONAL PARK** from entrée du park TUNISIA Feidja National Park

#### DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

El Feijda National Park is located in north-western Tunisia, west of Jendouba, and only a few kilometres away from the Algerian border. It's a beautiful forested area crossed by quietly flowing streams. The entire area is protected as it is home to the Barbary deer, a species endemic to the humid forests of North Africa. It has 2600 hectares of oak forest with a range of wildlife and several good hiking options. There are impressive, panoramic views over the thick forests, especially from Mount "Kef El Nagcha".

# 5. **EL-HAOUARIA** from Al Huwariyah to Eastern Hawaria

### DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

El-Haouaria is a quiet city close to the sea, located 50km from Nabeul. It has a population of 9000 inhabitants and it's famous for falconry. Many families are involved in this activity while others work in the agriculture, mainly peanut farming.

Close to the city there are the Haouaria grottos that were ancient Roman quarries, partly open and partly underground. The Bat Cave (French: Grotte des Chauves-souris) was declared a nature reserve in 1993.

### 6. OUED ZEN from Ain Draham to Pont Oued Ezzen

#### DESCRIPTION OF THE ROUTE

The Oued Zen National Park is located in the administrative area of Aïn Draham, about 200 kilometres west of Tunis and about fifty kilometres west of Jendouba. The park covers an area of 6700 hectares consisting mainly of Zeean oak forests.

The park is part of Kroumirie which is the wettest region of Tunisia and home to many local plant and animal species including the amazing Atlantic deer.

The rocky paths pass alongside areas of clear water, making it an ideal destination to spend quality time surrounded by nature. Walking is the best way to explore this natural greenery while also enjoying the cool water flowing into the valleys and the quietness of the forest.
