The Nexus Joint Action Plan (NJAP) is a policy-oriented outcome that drives management focus from inputs to outputs and boosts the achievements and results of the Nexus Driven Open Living Labs (NDOLLs). It is initiated to address future Water, Energy and Food (WEF) Nexus challenges in European Union - Mediterranean Partnership Countries (EU-MPCs) through design thinking dynamics. The NJAP is a roadmap that aids countries in their development of WEF oriented NDOLLs and helps them overcome barriers to the implementation process.


#### What is WEF Nexus?

## What are NDOLLs?


NDOLLS are networking spaces that integrate scientific, industry, government, and social actors into an interactive innovation process that matches supply and demand.

#### Assessment process for WEF solutions supported by NDOLLs


