The MED-InA project

Imagine a city with 35% more sorted waste and 90% of the citizens are opting for more eco-responsible behaviors... This is possible thanks to the GD6D™ method, a coaching method for local authorities and their citizens developed by the French company E3D-Environnement.

After having coached more than 150,000 households in Europe, E3D-Environment is launching the MED-INA project alongside 7 Mediterranean partners: the Agency for Sustainable Mediterranean Cities and Territories (FR), the American University of Beirut (LB), the Municipality of Irbid (JO), the Jordanian University of Science and Technology (JO), the Municipality of Marsa (MEGARA Network, TU) and the Consorci La Ribera (SP).

But, what is MED-InA? A 2M€ European project funded by the ENI CBC MED program, which aims at implementing a "Zero Waste" strategy in 3 municipalities: Irbid in Jordan, La Marsa in Tunisia and the selected municipality within the Ribera Region in Spain by:

- Coaching citizens towards more responsible behaviors;
- Coaching municipalities towards the implementation of "Zero Waste" management plans;
- Coaching circular economy start-ups in the development of local and innovative solutions.

Mission

E3D-Environnement is a French start-up created in 2009 that has developed a citizen exchange system based on a smart digital platform (GD6D™). It makes it possible to bring about real changes in the behavior of populations on a large scale, whatever their level of motivation at the outset in order to move towards more eco-responsibility. It is a solution at the heart of the problems of the ecological transition. With this device, people are listened and see that they are able to influence the offering services quality being connected to each other on important topics such as water and energy management, waste, mobility, health through food...

Attached to the Production Department, you will be integrated into the team in charge of the deployment of our awareness-raising and coaching projects for residents to enable them to change behaviours towards more eco-responsibility.

Your main mission will be to provide support to residents via the digital platform (email and telephone) as an always interesting and renewed experience from the point of view of the inhabitant.

After a successful period of integration and collaboration, you will be responsible for piloting a large-scale project to mobilize and support residents with the assistance of our operational partners.
