# 3. Purpose:

The Peer-to-Peer Consultancy Service provider will create a system in which the beneficiaries of MEDSt@rts and other ENI CBC MED projects beneficiaries will offer support to other aspiring entrepreneurs that will join the Marketplace Platform. Participants will provide professional counseling and advice for other aspiring entrepreneurs, focusing on sharing experiences, skills training, business guidance, professional contacts, or problem-solving. They will have a personal account on the MarketPlace Platform through which other aspiring entrepreneurs will be able to get in contact with them and easily communicate with them.

# 4. Scope of Work

- Support 120 Entrepreneurs in joining the Marketplace Platform
- Engage beneficiaries from MEDST@rts and other ENI CBC MED's previous projects to inspire participation in activities on the Marketplace Platform.
- Facilitate connections between previous beneficiaries and new beneficiaries by organizing seminars, speed meetings, or testimony talks. These events will;
  - Serve as a platform for knowledge sharing between aspiring and established entrepreneurs.
  - Ensure valuable discussions, expert/s will organize and moderate a minimum of five onehour events on the Marketplace Platform. These events will focus on specific topics that are crucial for entrepreneurs, such as fundraising, hiring, marketing and sales, research and development, and team dynamics.
- Organize sessions of financial training for users on the platform
- Organize Local Debates aiming on the one hand at testing and verifying the knowledge acquired, on the other hand at spreading the knowledge in the participant's local community. The Local Debates will allow a spillover effect in terms of the involvement of stakeholders and the dissemination and communications of content.
