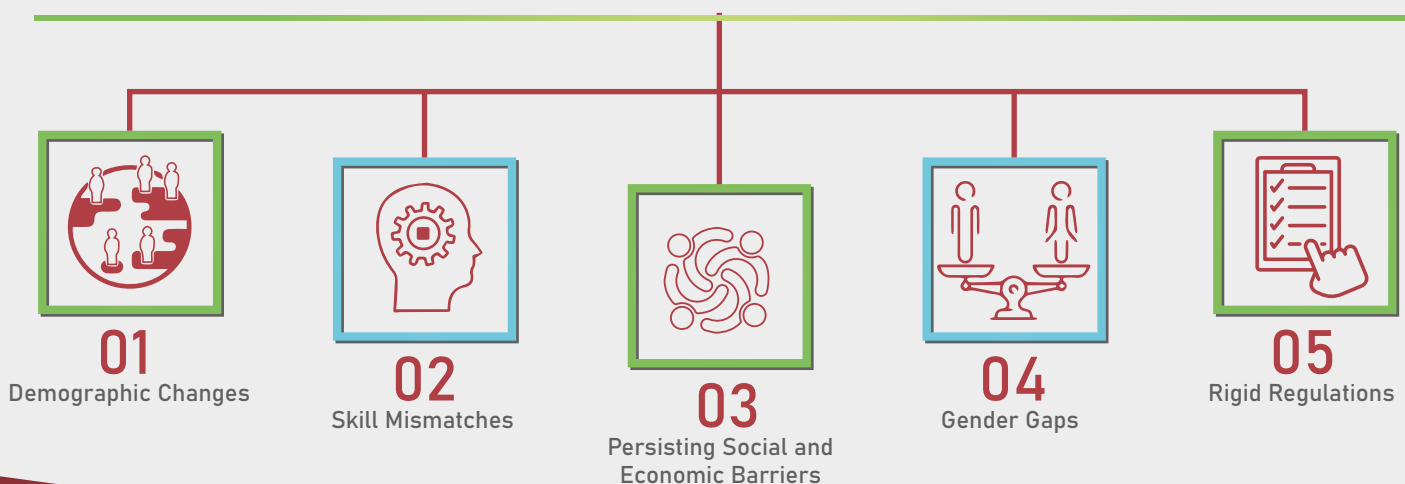

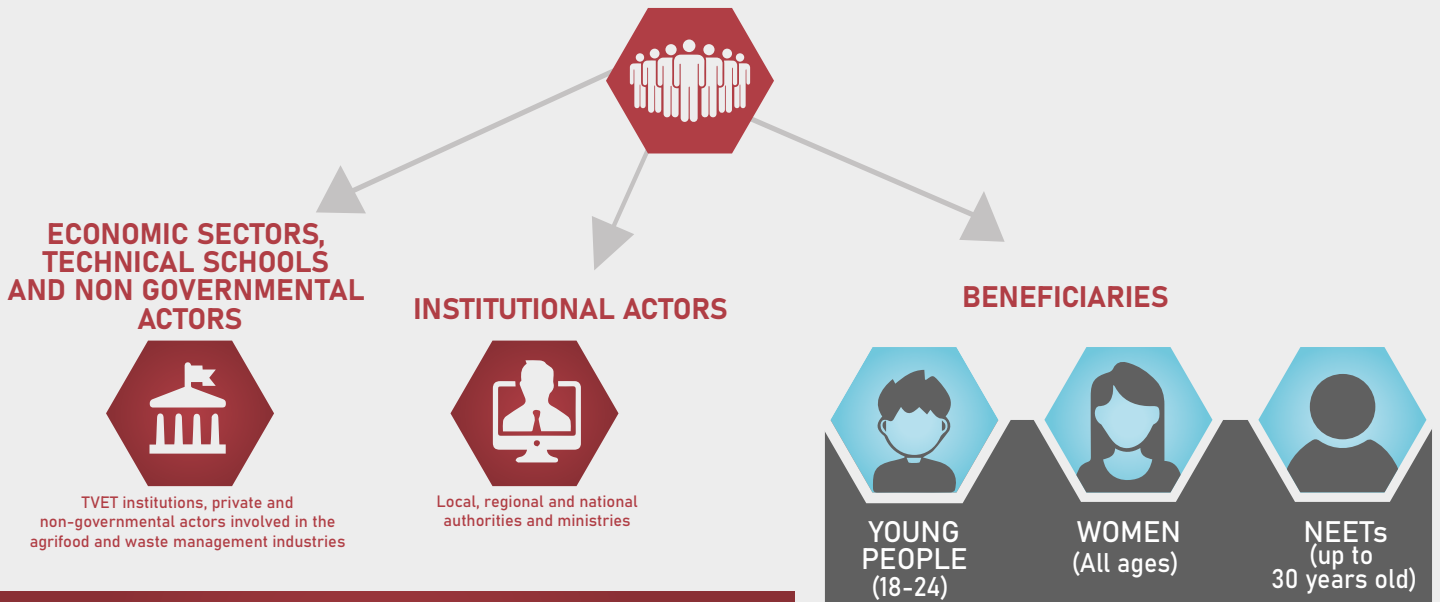
Contributed to economic activity decline.

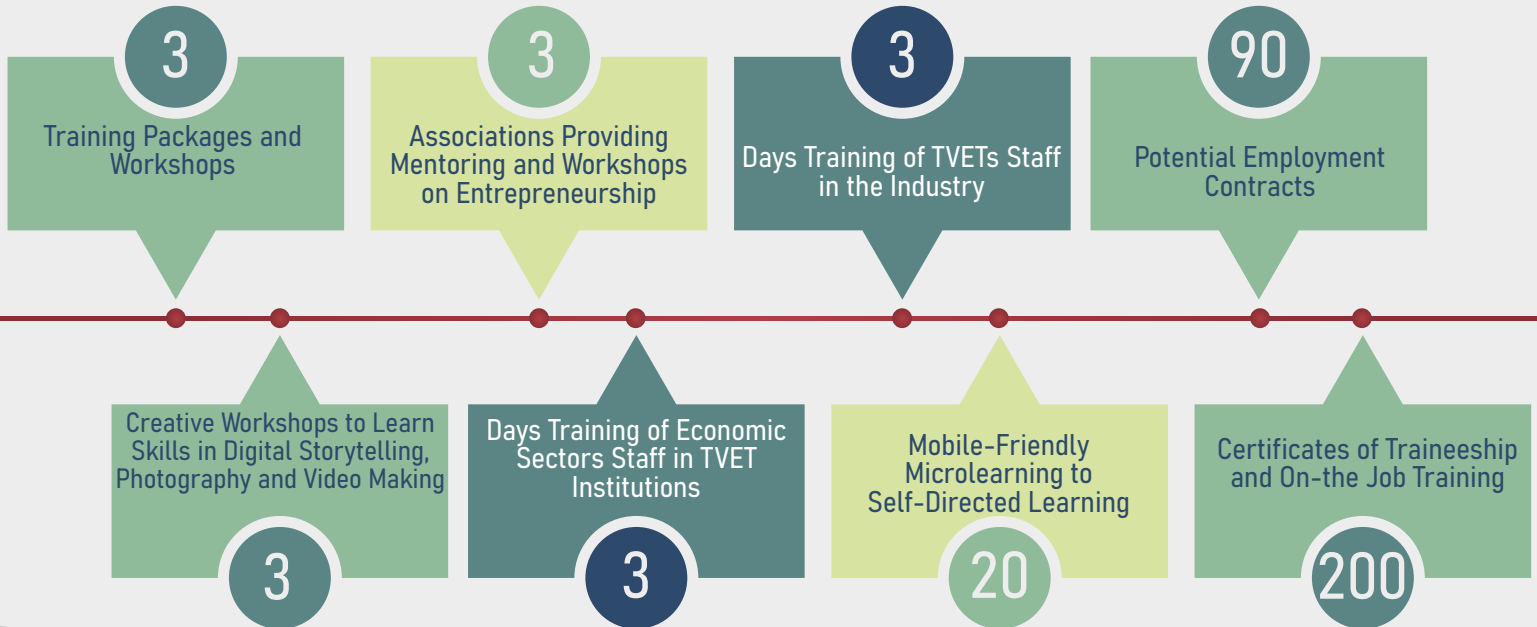
