

RESMYLE brings together 9 partner organisations from 5 countries of the Mediterranean: France, Italy, Jordan, Lebanon and Tunisia facing cross cutting issues on the difficulties of professional integration of young people, in particular NEETs and the challenges of environmental protection creating many new needs largely unfulfilled particularly in the lack of skills (i.e. waste sorting, eco-mobility, risk prevention, etc.).
