5. teamwork skills.

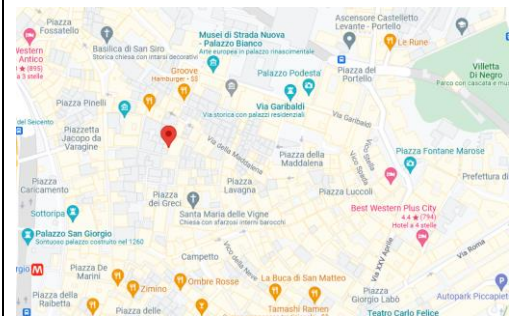
The working hour will be 6 for day, for 5 days in a week.



LOCATION

The project is situated in the hystorical Centre of Genoa, in Via Posta Vecchia 11r . In the centre of Genoa there are important and historical buildings such as Palazzi dei Rolli. Near the project location there is Acquario di Genova that is the largest exhibition of aquatic fauna in Europe. You can also take a walk in Porto Antico. There are a lot of shops and near the place there are the principle street of Genoa.

You are near to the Principe train station so, if you want, you can take a train and you can visit our Riviera (5 Terre, Arenzano, Savona, Imperia, La Spezia, Portofino) and you can spend a nice day at the beach (outside working hours).



WHAT TO BRING

The project will be at the middle of march until the middle of june. Please, bring your own sheets, swimsuit and towels for beach, music instruments if you can play some, games and something from your country to show to the local community. Do not forget your good humour, your curiosity and your energy!

INSURANCE

Volunteers living within the European Union must bring the *European International Insurance Card*.

All volunteers must be up-to-date with their vaccinations and those volunteers coming from outside the European Union must bring a copy of their health insurance policy coverage.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

There are two way to arrive in Genoa:

1. Milan airport: you take a bus and you arrive in Milano-San Donato M3 or you move from Milano Malpensa (or another airport) with Terravision bus (or another company bus) and you'll arrive in Milano Stazione Centrale. When you arrive in Milano Stazione Centrale you can take a train for Genova. In both case we'll wait you on Genoa Brignole or Genoa Principe station and we go together to your accommodation.
