





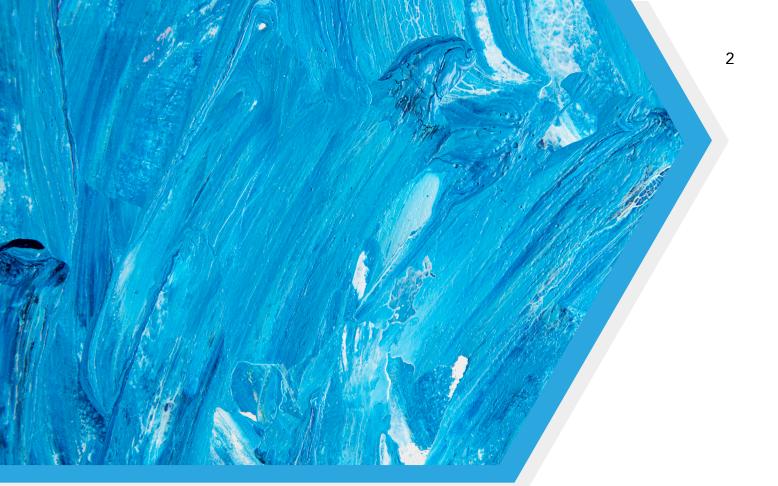

INVESTMED ABOUT

MSMEs in the Mediterranean region face important challenges in terms of sustainability, capacity to innovate, competitiveness and internationalisation. These challenges call for new solutions in order for MSMEs to maintain their existence and to enhance growth. Greening the economy, developing natural assets and enhancing innovation and creativity can provide economic, knowledge-based and environmental benefits to the Mediterranean region.

INVESTMED addresses economic and environmental challenges, supporting sustainable, creative and innovative business opportunities for young people and women in Egypt, Lebanon and Tunisia. INVESTMED is set to benefit MSMEs via training, and coaching and via sub-granting and to public authorities by enhancing their capacities to encourage and to facilitate access to Intellectual Property Rights (IPR).

INVESTMED has a duration of 30 months, with a total budget of €3.8 Million euro, of which €3.4 Million euro are funded by ENI CBC MED (90%)









INVESTMED **OBJECTIVE**

INVESTMED aims to support the development of sustainable entrepreneurship and business initiatives, by creating the business environment and by facilitating access to new markets with the final goal of generating increased economic opportunities and jobs for youth and women in Lebanon, Tunisia and Egypt.

Super Fny is a social enterprise specialized in vocational training and employment services of TVET students and graduates particularly and handicrafts generally to improve their competencies to fit the needs of the labor market.

The "Abis on the map" project by Super Fny is one its projects to promote countryside activities in Abis villages in Alexandria, Egypt to preserve Egyptian heritage, empower women and young people who live there and foster Responsible Tourism.



Plan for subgrant:

With the INVESTMED grant, Super Fny intend to preserve Egyptian heritage through improving efficiency of creating handicrafts in the Abis community as well as promoting responsible tourism and eco-friendly practices. They will increase their market share locally, train at least 70 women and young people, engage 8 to 15 villages in Abis, Alexandria, hold an exhibition to showcase the products made, and raise awareness to around 10,000 tourists on the countryside experience in Alexandria.

"The INVESTMED grant will help Super Fny conduct this project with the needed tools and experienced trainers, reaching more tourists and entities interested in supporting sustainable tourism through our media platforms, organizing the trips, and holding exhibitions offline and online through developing a specific page for it on our website."

Plan for subgrant:

The main action Wastology will implement with the INVESTMED grant is to



initiate their operations and activities in Alexandria. They will establish two supply routes to progressively increase their share of production in the market attracting investors. This would allow them to complete the cycle of their product.

To do this, they will improve their internal processes and improve energy resource and efficiency.

Plan for subgrant:

With the INVESTMED subgrant, B'sarya will support the Alexandrian artistic scene, and new talents. Through launching the second edition of B'AV-Lab (B'sarya Audio/visual Lab) which consists of series of artistic residencies and invites young emerging artists from the fields of music and new media who will work together collaboratively under the mentorship of a more established mentors exploring many potential relationships of incorporating music and visual arts together and create a unique original interdisciplinary artwork that will be presented to a public audience in a live exhibition/performance by the end of each residency.

Plan for subgrant:

With the INVESTMED subgrant, Plstka aims to increase their recycling capacity and will develop their products using an Al tracking system, a chatbot for customers, and expand their services to 5 different cities.

New Power are an Egyptian company specialized in the production of Alternative Fuels for the cement industry, specifically (RDF - Refuse Derived Fuel) and waste management. Their strategy is to integrate waste management expertise with know-how concerning the optimization of Alternative Fuels in co-processing, covering the entire value chain from the waste mapping to the final incineration in the cement plant.



Plan for subgrant:

With the INVESTMED subgrant, they are aiming to expand their operations and produce 150 tons of Refuse Derived Fuel a day. This means expanding their facilities, increasing their team, and adding a new line for separation and sorting. This will contribute to job creation for young people and women whilst providing the Egyptian market with alternative fuels.

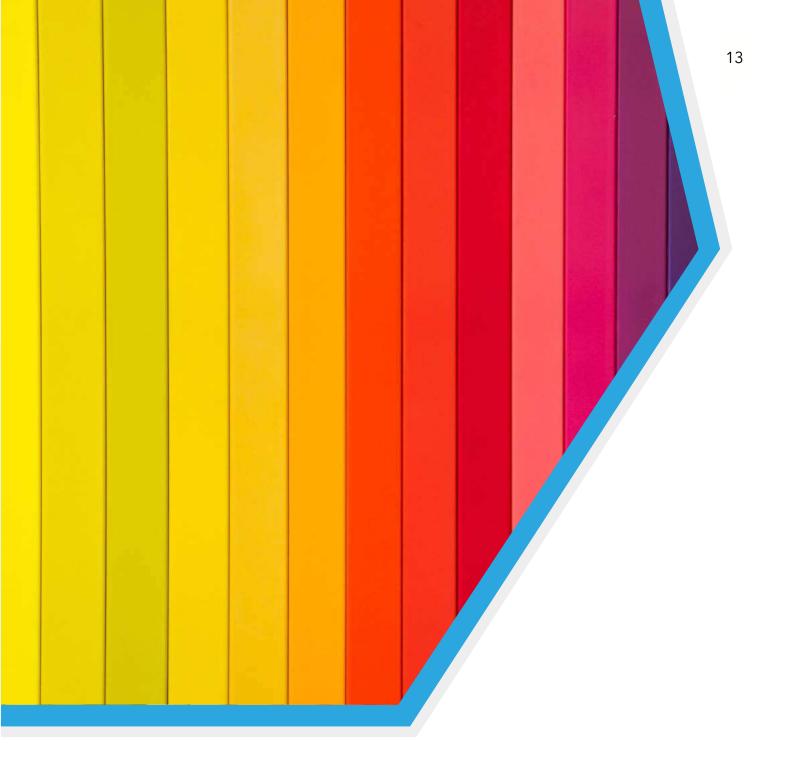
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
