SEACAP 4 SDG WORKSHOP "Sustainable Energy and Climate Action Plans (Seacaps) in Alicante" IN SPAIN

The **SEACAP 4 SDG project**, funded by the European Union under the ENI CBC Med Programme, aims to find innovative solutions and tools to reduce energy consumption in public buildings through cost-effective approaches to energy refurbishment, integrating **Sustainable Energy Access and Climate Action Plans and Innovative Support Mechanisms for Cities**.

The **SEACAP 4 SDG partners**, in collaboration with Spanish municipalities, institutional entities and selected local experts, will host the open workshop "*Sustainable Energy and Climate Action Plans* (*Seacaps*) in *Alicante*" to be held in presence next **Wednesday July 12**th (*11:30 am* – *03:00 pm*, *local time*) at *Muséo Arquéologico dé Alicanté*, in Alicante (Spain). The interventions will be in English and in Spanish.

During the day, the **Agencia Provincial de la Energía de Alicante** (Alicante Provincial Energy Agency) will explain its role as the coordinator of the Covenant and the creation of the "*Planes de Acción para el Clima y la Energía Sostenible*" (Climate and Sustainable Energy Action Plan – SECAPs) in order to help municipalities to implement their SEAPS at source and their current SECAPs. Namely, the experience of the municipality of **Sax** through the SEACAP 4SDG project, and best practice cases of **Alicante** municipalities in the development and monitoring of their SEAPS, such as **Salinas** and **Almoradí**.

The face-to-face workshop is **free** and is especially aimed at **technical staff** from **local public administrations** involved in the drafting and monitoring of these SECAP.
