General objective

- The general objective of GreenBuilding is to ***contribute to environmental protection by effectively reducing energy consumption in public buildings***, while respecting present uses and public needs.



Specific objective (1/3)

- Provide ***innovative building energy refurbishment plans*** and measures that increase capacity of public institutions to respond to environmental impacts of high energy consumption.
- Provide ***methods that increase the capacity of users*** to use refurbished buildings effectively.



Specific objective (2/3)

- ***Plan and support cost-effective energy refurbishment*** of public buildings across climatic zones ***(Greece, Tunisia, Jordan)*** using renewable energy and energy efficiency measures
- Monitor effectiveness of refurbishment using energy measuring devices provided by the energy SMEs sector.



Specific objective (3/3)

Enhance and promote ecological use of public buildings,

- abiding by their traditional use and social role in the community,
- identifying cost-effective approaches to energy refurbishment and use,
- strengthening learning processes that ***ensure sustainable transition to a low carbon economy.***



Expected Results

- 4.3.1: Enhanced capacity of public institutions to plan and implement sustainable energy policies and measures with regard to public buildings
- 4.3.2: Reduced and cleaner energy consumption in public buildings through the use of renewable energy measures and energy saving interventions

The challenges of writing the proposal (1/2)

Form is constrained: priorities, outputs, indicators ... partly predefined

- Study the manual from start of writing
- Formulate proposal according to these constraints
- ASK questions!

Budget balance between EU countries, MPCs

- Respect logic of the program
- Entrust responsibilities to MPCs



The challenges of writing the proposal (2/2)

Building a meaningful partnership

- Identify strengths/ weaknesses of each partner.
- Entrust specific responsibilities to certain partners according to their expertise

Showing care in writing

- Be direct and precise
- Prepare a word file and check often the character limits.



Development of the partnership

- ✓ **Previous cooperation** between partners - Trusted relationships, knowledge of expertise/competence
- ✓ **Partners identified** from info days & registration lists
- ✓ **Partners recommended** by organizations with previous experience in ENPI
- ✓ **Team tele-conferences** and bilateral exchanges during the writing process
- ✓ **Project development process** over *4 months*

Tips for building meaningful partnership



Tips for designing proposal (1/2)

1. Build proposal based on cooperation:

- all partners contribute to development of methods, so they are transferable

2. If include policies, integrate public actors

- who are in charge of the policies of targeted field: partners / associated partners



Tips for designing proposal (2/2)

3. Be specific: Objectives, outputs, impacts, actions.

- Describe things concretely.
- Which outputs are best for which result?

4. Check sustainability of output and results: *Who will use them? Will this issue be important in the future?*

- Hard to know in advance when writing a proposal but key element for evaluation.
