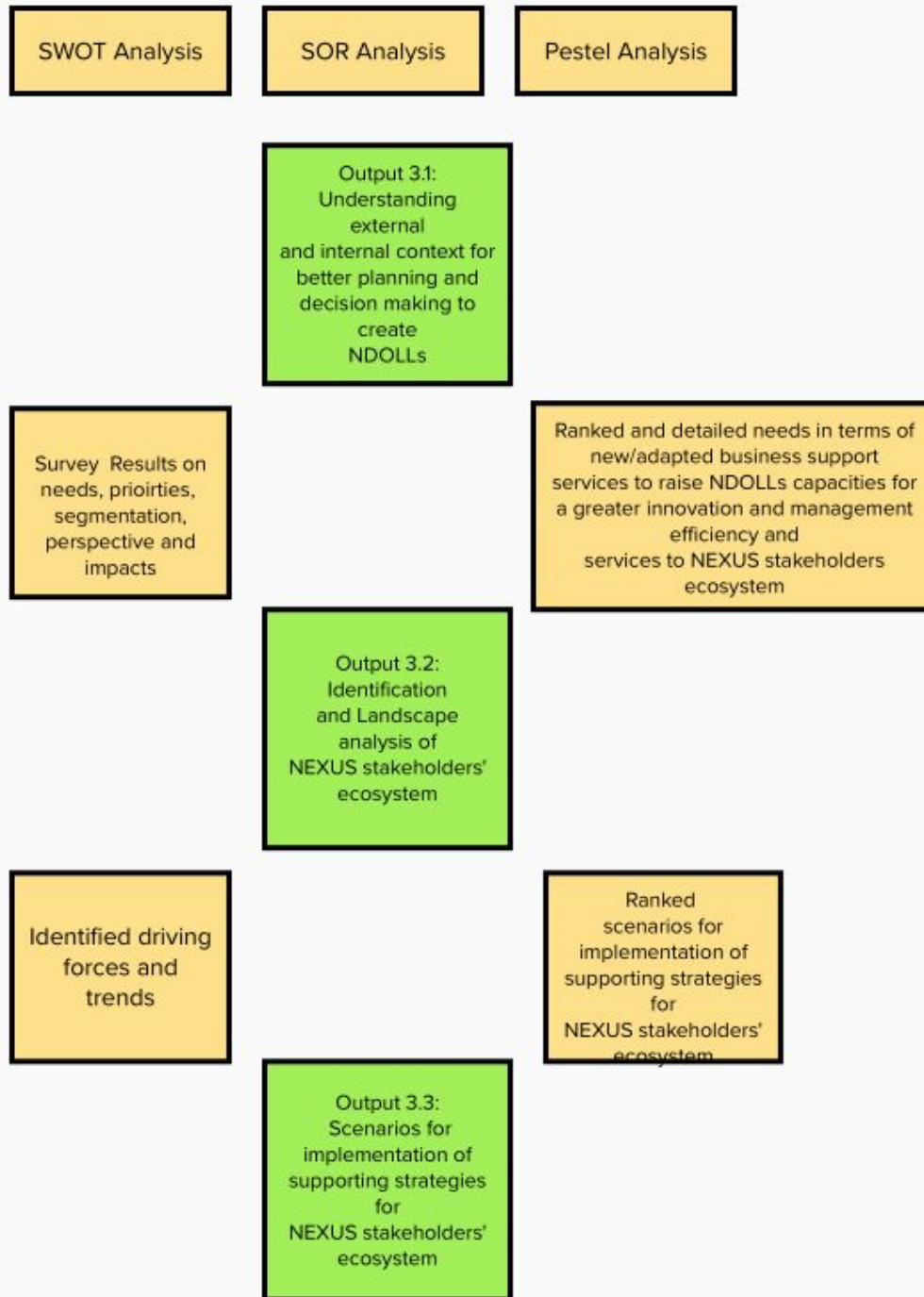
Nexus Joint Action Plan

- Policy oriented outcome to:
 - support replication of NDOLs approach
 - drive management focus from inputs to outputs
 - boost results of NDOLs to address future WEF NEXUS challenges in EU-MPC through design thinking dynamics
- Complemented by a decision-making tool (DMT) for NEXUS stakeholders to solve complex problems related to NEXUS challenges step by step considering available produced information and tested practices through NDOLs
- Local/regional/national/multilateral public authorities (policy-making), Civil society and TTOs



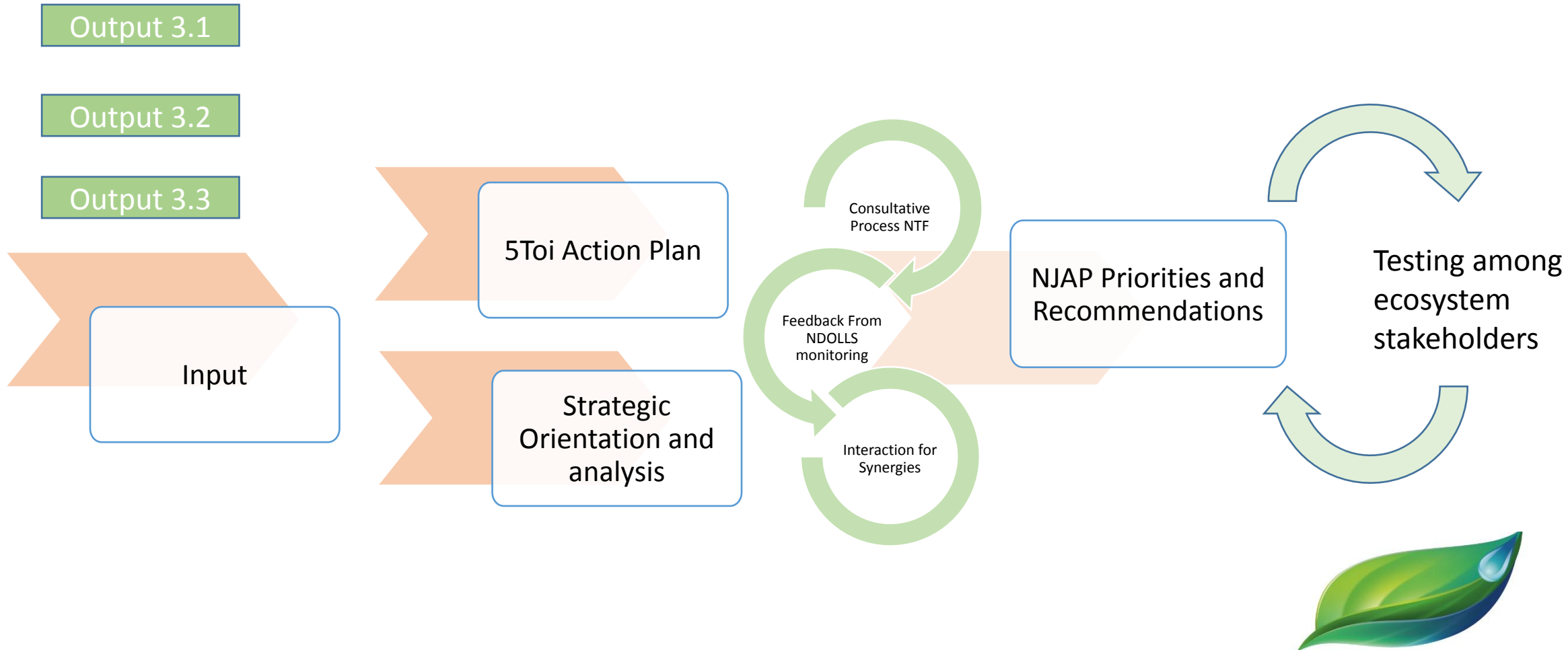


Key Project Outputs
