



INFORMATION ON SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

The Royal Scientific Society, RSS, is the lead beneficiary of the project "The Technology Transfer and Capitalization of Water Energy Food NEXUS – WEF-CAP" funded by the multilateral cross-border cooperation program "Mediterranean Sea Basin", implemented by the EU under the European Neighbourhood Instrument (ENI).

The project budget is 1.1 million euros, (RSS budget 265.357,86 euros). The project is implemented over two years starting 14/9/2021 and its purpose is to combine the capitalization and expansion of tools and methodologies used for innovation commercialization with the capitalization of Water-Energy-Food innovations in efficient practices for replication across the Mediterranean area.

According to the project implementation manual, a certified JCPA accountant is required for verification of the expenses and actions of the project. Furthermore, the auditor will be obliged to attend relevant training seminars organized by the national contact point of the Program.

The Auditor shall execute the tasks assigned to him in accordance with the procedures and templates annexed to these terms of reference or any update issued by the Managing Authority or the Joint Technical Secretariat.
